Timber and Paper Procurement Policy Statement

Marshalls is committed to ensuring that all the timber and paper used in the course of our business is sourced with consideration to its impact on the natural environment and ultimately that it is independently certified under an appropriate scheme.

Marshalls uses only a small quantity of timber in our finished products. The vast majority of the group's timber is procured for packaging purposes. The group's paper usage is for marketing collateral and day to day administration of business operations.

Marshalls' policy is to:

- Track, understand and implement all relevant legislation in relation to timber and paper procurement and satisfying our compliance obligations.
- To work with our suppliers to deliver 'chain of custody' certification under an appropriate scheme in the following key areas:
 - Timber for finished products
 - Timber for packaging
 - Paper for marketing collateral
- To set targets for timber and paper and report transparently on progress
- Continue to improve awareness and training across the Group.

This Timber and Paper Procurement Policy will be reviewed annually.
